GUINEA PIG CARE PROGRAM 2013

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- **Making Sure the Guinea Pigs Have Adequate Food** (each week day), which includes the following food items:
 1. Fresh Fruit
 2. Fresh Vegetables and Herbs
 3. Natural Premium Timothy Hay
 4. Kaytee Forti-Diet Pro Health Cleaning Out Food Dishes
- **Cutting Up Fresh Fruit, Vegetables and Herbs** (one or more days per week), which may include the following food items:
 1. Apples
 2. Seedless Grapes
 3. Green Peppers
 4. Red Peppers
 5. Yellow Peppers
 6. Green Beans
 7. Celery
 8. Cucumbers
 9. Carrots
 10. Lettuce
 11. Chives
 12. Parsley
- **Caring for Guinea Pig Cage Area** (each week day), which includes the following activities:
 1. Procuring the Garbage Can
 2. Using Broom and Dustpan to Clean Off Table and Floor in Guinea Pig Cage Area
 3. Using Scooper to Scoop Up the Guinea Pig Waste and to Clean Out the Wet Spots in the Entire Cage
 4. Putting Back the Garbage Can
 5. Washing Your Hands
- **Cleaning the Guinea Pig Cage** (1-2 times per week), which includes the following activities:
 1. Procuring the Garbage Can
 2. Washing Your Hands
 3. Removing Guinea Pigs From Cage
 4. Removing Top of Cage
 5. Taking Out Guinea Pig Toys, Food Dishes and Water Bottle
 6. Emptying Water Bottle and Replacing Water (and adding 10 drops of Vita-Drops to Fresh Water – extra Vitamin C)
 7. Dumping Cage Contents into Garbage Can
 8. Using Soap and Water to Clean the Cage
 9. Drying the Cage Using Paper Towels
 10. Replacing Paper Bedding (1"-2" of bedding) on the Bottom of the Cage
 11. Washing, Rinsing and Drying the Food Bowls of the Guinea Pigs

12. Placing Fresh Fruit, Vegetables and Herbs and also Kaytee Forti-Diet Pro Health in the Food Bowls of the Guinea Pigs
 13. Cleaning the Sink and Counters in Kitchen (after cleaning the cage of the guinea pigs)
 14. Putting Food Dishes Back into the Cage
 15. Putting Natural Premium Timothy Hay in Cage
 16. Putting Top of Cage Back in Place
 17. Putting Guinea Pigs Back in Cage
 18. Washing Your Hands
- **Bathing the Guinea Pigs in the Sink** (as needed)
 - **Brushing the Hair of the Guinea Pigs** (as needed)
 - **Grooming the Guinea Pigs** (Nail Care as needed, Staff Only)
 - **Giving the Guinea Pigs T-L-C** (Tender Loving Care, as much as possible)
